Motion to fund sex toy disinfectant

Proposer: Maria Bassi

Seconder: Paula Gomez

This JCR notes that: (Facts about the current situation)

- 1) As noted by the NHS, the main mode of STI transmission among lesbian and bisexual women is the sharing of sex toys
- 2) The aforementioned issue also applies to individuals of other sexualities and genders
- 3) A recent survey, published by the Cherwell, has found that Oxford University students are the most prolific users of sex toys amongst university students in the UK
- 4) Currently the JCR does not fund disinfectants for sex toys
- 5) Other JCRs have funded the provision of sex toy disinfectants for their members

This JCR believes that: (Why the situation should be changed)

- 1) Normalisation and safe use of sex toys should be encouraged and informed
- 2) That providing sex toy disinfectant would raise awareness around issues of sexual health and protect JCR members from the spread of STIs

This JCR therefore resolves to: (What do you propose we do?)

- 1) To spend £16 of the budget to buy 60 individual sex toy disinfecting wipes
